



Roof & Path Cleaner (Concentrate)

Many walls, roofs, pathways and drives are contaminated by dirt and organic growth, especially on north elevations and near trees.

The removal of this dirt and grime without affecting the stone, slate, render or brickwork enhances the appearance of the property. Grime and dirt on paths, walkways, forecourts and patios causes slippery surfaces, which can be a danger to residents, particularly the elderly.

APPLICATION AREAS

For use on roofs – slates, tiles, shingles

For use on walls – render, stone, brickwork

For use on timber – fencing, gates, sheds

For use on walking areas – paths, patios, driveways and forecourts

APPLICATION METHOD

Dilute 1 part Biokil Crown Roof and Drive Cleaner concentrate with 4 parts clean water and apply by brush, working into the areas to be cleaned, or by low volume spray. Any badly soiled areas should be left for 24 hours before scrubbing with a stiff brush.

A second application of the diluted Biokil Crown Roof and Drive Cleaner may be necessary on severely soiled surfaces.

Apply in dry conditions at a rate of approximately 5m²/Litre (this will vary depending on the porosity and condition of the substrate) and leave to take effect.

For extra thick layers of surface contaminants remove by **scraping** and **brushing** before applying Biokil Crown Roof and Drive Cleaner.
